S. Prospect St: Pearl-Main

**Water mains will be rehabilitated prior to paving on these streets. You will receive additional notification about these projects.*

Please contact DPW Customer Service for up to date information.

Now is the time to consider replacing water & sewer services – potential for cost savings for homeowners.

Water: DPW will be replacing galvanized water services in the roadway at no cost to property owners before paving.

Replacement of other water service line material types (e.g. copper in the roadway) are eligible for 50% cost share. The cost of service work outside the roadway, by ordinance, is fully the responsibility of the property owner. Please note that DPW-Water can offer 12-month payment plans for waterline work. **If our records show you have a galvanized water service or unknown service type you will receive an additional letter from DPW.**

An example of corrosion in a galvanized waterline is below



Sewer: Sewer services are owner responsibility, by ordinance. Many sewer services are at risk of being in poor or failing condition.

Deadlines: By **March 30**, we must have written notification of your intent to do water or sewer service upgrade work. Sewer service work must be completed by **June 28, 2019**.
