QUESTIONS RECEIVED BY 4:00 PM ON May 2, 2016

Most VTrans projects have separate pay items for the traffic control, flaggers, and attenuator trucks for projects so that inspectors can add more if they deem necessary. Would these items be able to be added to the bid in case the inspector requires additional traffic control over what the contractor would use?

ANSWER:

Traffic control will be coordinated by the contractor. This Addendum includes an updated "Attachment A – Bid Form" and an updated "Introduction and General Scope of Work" to reflect line items that may be needed for traffic control.

INTRODUCTION AND GENERAL SCOPE OF WORK

The City of Burlington is seeking bids from qualified firms to provide construction services on North Avenue, Burlington VT, beginning at the southerly point of the intersection of Plattsburg Avenue and North Avenue and continuing southerly to the northerly point of the intersection of Washington Street and North Avenue.

The City is looking for the following tasks to be included in the bid:

- 1) The project includes removal of existing lane markings and the installation of new temporary lane markings. Work for the project includes furnishing all equipment, materials and labor necessary to complete the following VTrans bid item numbers as depicted in the North Avenue Pilot Project Conceptual Plans dated 4/19/2016 by Stantec:
 - a. 646.201 - 4" white line (parking, fog lines)
 - b. 646.2141 - 6" white line (bike lane lines)
 - c. 626.2111 - 4" yellow line
 - d. 900.620 - Bike stencils, arrows, chevrons; waterborne paint
 - e. 646.301 - Letter or Symbol
 - f. 646.261 - 24" Stop Bar
 - g. 646.85 - Removal of existing pavement markings
 - h. 630.10 – Uniformed Traffic Officers (not depicted in the 4/19/2016 plans)
 - i. 630.15 – Flaggers
 - j. 635.11 – Mobilization / Demobilization
 - k. 641.10 – Traffic Control
- 2) Bidders are hereby warned that they must work in compliance with all Occupational Safety & Health Ordinances, as well as provide all necessary traffic control as outlined in "ATSSA GUIDE for Work Area Traffic Control". Public Works reserves the right to stop all work until the contractor is in compliance.
- 3) The bidder is to furnish all materials, labors, equipment, and miscellaneous supplies necessary to complete all work.
- 4) The City will assist in posting "No Parking" signs so that streets may be cleaned by the City before they are painted by the successful bidder.
- 5) Traffic cones must be used to protect all freshly applied markings.
- 6) All equipment must be in good operating order to ensure that all lines are straight, evenly applied, uniform thickness, and clear sharp edges.
- 7) All materials must be used as specified by VTrans Approved Materials List or approved equivalent as specified in the provided site plans.
- 8) Perform work in accordance with applicable rules, regulations, codes, and ordinances of local, State and Federal authorities, and in accordance with the requirements of public utility corporations having jurisdiction over the work.
- 9) Obtain and pay for necessary permits, licenses and certificates and give notices as required during the performance of the work.
- 10) Do not close or obstruct streets or sidewalks without the proper permit. Conduct operations with minimal traffic interference
