After the Polls Close: Where does it all belong?

OUTSIDE THE BALLOT BAGS:

- Tabulator in case with sealed memory cards and first, signed tabulator tape, sealed inside.
 Note: Do NOT seal the tabulator chain of custody form. Bring the Chain of Custody Form to City
 Hall with the sealed tabulator as soon as possible after the polls close.
- Entrance Checklist for the Legislative District or Ward
- Ballot Chain of Custody Form (signed, in the red folder)
- End of Night Results Form with written explanation of any discrepancies between the Entrance Checklist and number of voted ballots (signed, in the red folder)
- Completed Summary Sheet(s) (there should be NO hand counted ballots all should have been transferred and fed into the tabulator). All write-ins must be written legibly (please combine all erroneous or fictitious votes into one line item total) (signed, in the red folder)
- o All unused ballots
- Open, emptied (used) absentee ballot envelopes (in metal box).
- o Remainder of Supplies contained in the "Blue Box"

PLACE INSIDE DESIGNATED BALLOT BAG AND SEAL:

- o All voted ballots (separate Legislative Districts, City or State, if appropriate)
 - 1. Do not put more than 1500 ballots in one ballot bag (about 12" of stacked ballots)
 - 2. Do not mix ballots from different legislative districts
 - 3. Do not mix voted and unvoted ballots unvoted ballots belong in a separate bag
- Second printed tape from the tabulator (signed). This is the second copy of the tabulator tape.
- Defective Ballot Envelope containing ballots that cannot be counted for any of the reasons stated on the envelope (*You will need to account for these when reconciling the Entrance Checklist to the number of voted ballots on your End of Night Results form*).
- Replaced Ballot Envelope containing ballots that were surrendered by voters who obtained a new ballot (*Do not include these when reconciling the Entrance Checklist to the number of* voted ballots).
- Transferred Ballot Envelope containing ballots that were unable to be read by the tabulator and were transferred to a new ballot that could be fed through the tabulator (*Do not include these when reconciling the Entrance Checklist to the number of voted ballots*).
- Contents List to be placed in outside pocket of each ballot bag
- Make sure all bags have a tag attached stating "Election Date", "Ward and/or District", and Destroy date (22 months to the future for State and Federal, 3 months to the future for local).

DO NOT BAG AND/OR SEAL THE ENTRANCE CHECKLIST!
