

BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS
MINUTES OF MEETING

A meeting of the Board of Police Commissioners was held in the Burlington Police Department Community Room on **Friday, April 17, 2015**. Chair Kenney called the meeting to order at 8:08 a.m.

Additions or Modifications to Agenda:

~Chair Kenney moved to add a discussion on the Community Forum for the next Chief of Police position to the agenda. Commissioner Hochanadel seconded, all in favor, so passed.

Community Forum for the next Chief of Police position:

Lieutenant Promotion Process:

~Commissioner Miles moved to promote Sergeant Paul Glynn to the rank of Lieutenant, effective May 3, 2015. Commissioner Hochanadel seconded, all in favor, so passed.
