**1. 15-0042CA/CU: 80 COLCHESTER AVENUE (I, Ward 1) Randall Miller & Frank Von Turkovich**

Conditional use to change from institutional office to community center/membership club/place of worship; replace exterior staircase and install bike rack.

**2. 10-1005CA/MA: 475 LAKE STREET (DW-PT, Ward 3) City of Burlington**

Time extension request for redevelopment of the Moran Plant (including amendment) into public-private uses and associated site works and car parking. Upgrades to bike path, increased green space and park amenities, children's splash area/seasonal refrigerated skating rink and a rebuilt skate park. Includes Community Sailing Center.

Plans may be viewed in the Planning and Zoning Office, (City Hall, 149 Church Street, Burlington), between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.
