[@Scott Gustin](#) , apologies for the delayed response. There were 6-8 trees that were 8" + in diameter. Some of these were girdled as their original supports were never removed. When I arrived on site I asked the tree workers to keep the last remaining girdled tree even though they thought it wouldn't survive. There were many shrub trees (3" -) that were also removed, and I just don't have a good count. I would estimate a few dozen given the length of the clearing performed.

Since this is after the fact, I can't be 100% certain about the exact dimensions and count, but to the best of my knowledge at the moment these numbers seem realistic. Come the spring, or if the snow holds off, I can always go out and count stumps on site if needed.
