Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

1 That WHEREAS, the mission statement of the Mayor’s Advisory Committee on Accessibility is: “The City  
2 recognizes that communities excel when all citizens are able to fully participate in all aspects of community  
3 life. The Advisory Committee on Accessibility shall assist and advise the Mayor, the City Council and City  
4 departments on ways to increase opportunities for people with disabilities and meet the needs of people with  
5 disabilities by encouraging full and equal participation in all aspects of life. This includes the identification  
6 and removal of architectural, procedural, programmatic, attitudinal and communication barriers, and strong  
7 advocacy for policies, programs and services that meet the needs of people with disabilities;” and

8 WHEREAS, the Committee membership was approved by the City Council on December 3, 2012 and  
9 the Committee is made up of City staff and community members charged with developing strategies to  
10 address accessibility in the City; and

11 WHEREAS, on March 18, 2013, the Committee presented an Accessibility Strategy and Plan to the  
12 City Council that identified strategies and action items for increasing accessibility to the City of Burlington’s  
13 programs, infrastructure, and workforce; and

14 WHEREAS, the Committee has continued to meet monthly and bring a range of City stakeholders  
15 together to address accessibility needs; and

16 WHEREAS, the Committee recommends reducing its membership from 14 to 11 members to ensure  
17 consistent participation and representation; and
