RE: 2020-2022 Joint Intuitional Parking Management Plan extension request

CATMA is requesting a 6-month extension of the current Joint Institutional Parking Management Plan (JIPMP). The JIPMP was approved December 1, 2020 for 2 years. Typically, the plans are valid for 5 years; however, a number of concerns were identified in review of the JIPMP at that time. CATMA is currently working on a new JIPMP, but it will not be complete until spring of 2023. As a result, a 6-month extension for the current JIPMP is requested so that there is no lapse.

The version of Article 8: *Parking* that is currently effective and warned for public hearing and adoption by the City Council in January 2023 specifically enables the DRB to approve one JIPMP extension of up to six months, so long as the request is made prior to expiration of the plan. Such is the case here. The extension request was made November 4, 2022 prior to the December 1 expiration of the plan.
