Background – Available Funding

- Action Plan for Entitlement (ENT) 2021
 - Covers an implementation period starts 7/1/2021 with a target completion date of 6/30/2022
 - \$759,765 in CDBG ENT 2021
 - \$414,413 in HOME ENT 2021
- Substantial Amendment to the ENT 2020 Action Plan
 - \$96,535 from ENT 2020 CDBG that we propose to reallocate
 - Funding period started 7/1/2020

Background – Timeline

- Accepted CDBG ENT21 applications – **complete**
- Convened the Advisory Board – **complete**
- Public Forum for input on 4/26/2021 - **today**

Yet to be completed:

- Present to the CDNR for input in early May (date TBD)
- Target for CC and BoF approval on May 10th
- Submittal to HUD on May 11th (due no later than May 15th, 2021)

Helpful Background:

- HUD lifted the Public Service Cap of 15% for entitlement years 2019 and 2020
- The advisory board decided to fund all CDBG applications received as there were sufficient funds available
