Chittenden County Courthouse, 180 Church Street, Burlington, Vermont**

Dear Ms. O'Neil:

We are writing to inform you that the above-referenced property will be considered by the Vermont Advisory Council on Historic Preservation for removal from the National Register of Historic Places at its meeting on **January 21, 2016**.

Constructed in 1872, the Chittenden County Courthouse was listed in the National Register of Historic Places on April 11, 1973. The building suffered a devastating fire in February 1982 and was subsequently demolished. Because the building is no longer standing, it does not meet the criteria for listing in the National Register of Historic Places.

Removal of this property from the National Register is being requested by the Vermont Division for Historic Preservation. As part of the removal process, we are required to notify the Burlington Historic Preservation Review Committee (HPRC) of our intent to take this request to the Vermont Advisory Council on Historic Preservation.


