

URBAN DISTRICT BUILDING INVENTORY

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336 North Winooski Avenue, c. 1885

The majority of this commercial building was built c. 1960s (the present day street facade with garage), however, the rectangular gable roof block and ell that are still visible incorporated into the northeastern part of the structure, are much older. These structures may have once been outbuildings or barns for other properties. The main block and ell are two stories in height with wood clapboards and imbricated shingle work in the gable peaks.

338/340 North Winooski Avenue, c. 1885

A 2-story, flat roof, vernacular Italianate style building with a bracketed cornice and a similar cornice dividing the first and second story. At one time this building was a commercial store but the large windows have been removed and replaced by a 1/1 sash and a three-part picture window. The primary entrances are located at the northern end of the building and in the center of the street (west) facade (approximately). The building is clad in aluminum siding with asphalt shingles on the lower story of the street facade. A 2-story shed roof porch extends off the rear.

a. Garage, c. 1980

1 story, one bay, brick gable roof garage with overhead door.
