Subject: Draft Invasive Species Condition

Here is the draft invasive species condition for Item IV.2 on the next BCB agenda. Could you include it with the packet, so folks have a chance to review it ahead of the meeting?

"All loam, dirt, fill, and other landscaping materials (including mulch) shall be free of seeds and live plant matter from species that are listed as Class A or Class B Noxious Weeds on the Vermont Agency of Agriculture Noxious Weed List.

Prior to issuance of a certificate of occupancy, the applicant, project engineer or other official with applicable personal knowledge shall certify in writing that the loam, dirt, fill, and/or other landscaping materials (including mulch) are free of seeds and live plant material from species listed as Class A or Class B Noxious Weeds on the Vermont Agency of Agriculture Noxious Weed List. This certification shall be filed with the Department of Planning & Zoning."
