RE: Turning Point Center Event Sound Waiver for July 31st, 2021

Request for waiver at Battery Park to allow amplified sound for an event with a live music performance.

Turning Point Center of Chittenden County is a dedicated, compassionate community that provides recovery support services in a safe, substance-free environment for individuals and families on multiple paths to self-discovery and sustained recovery. Their event, "Party Sober in Vermont" will focus on celebrating people in recovery through music, food and community. This event will be free and open to the public. There will be local community partners tabling as well as a performance. They are requesting to have amplified sound during their event and have already booked the park.

This event will feature live music and speakers. The amplified sound will take place between 3pm – 6pm. They are expecting about 500 people to attend.
