

# August 17, 2021 Ward 3 Special Election Information

## Early Voting

- All active, registered Ward 3 voters will be mailed a ballot by July 2.
- If you do not receive your ballot by July 12, please contact the Clerk/Treasurer's Office at (802) 865-7000 (option 1) or [elections@burlingtonvt.gov](mailto:elections@burlingtonvt.gov)
- Carefully follow all of the instructions when completing your absentee ballot. Be sure to SIGN the envelope and SEAL your ballot inside of it, or your vote will not count.
- Return the voted ballot:
  - At City Hall Monday through Friday, 8-12:30 and 1:30-4:30  
\*\*\*PLEASE NOTE\*\*\* City Hall will be closed on Monday, August 16
  - At a Ballot Drop Box located at:
    - City Hall – Main Street side of the building across from the Flynn Theater
    - Fire Station #2 – 132 North Avenue, rear of building
  - At the Ward 3 polling place, the Sustainability Academy/Lawrence Barnes Elementary School, 123 North St., on Election Day between 7am and 7pm

## In-Person Voting

- Polling places will be open from 7am to 7pm on Election Day
- Bring the ballot that was sent to you in the mail with you. If you did not receive a ballot or do not bring it with you, you will still be able to vote, but you will be asked to sign an affidavit first.

## Important Dates

July 2 – Ballots Mailed to all registered voters

August 13, 4:30pm – deadline to drop your ballot off at City Hall

August 16, 1pm – deadline to register to vote before Election Day

August 16, 4:30pm – deadline to drop off your voted ballot at in a drop box

August 17 – Election Day. Polls open 7am-7pm
