Revised FY2006 Housing Trust Fund Awards: Summary & Approval

This memo supercedes the October 28, 2005 memo. After the HTF Committee approved the grants for fiscal year 2006 on September 14, 2005, \$15,000 in additional funds became available from a payment to satisfy the requirements of the Housing Replacement ordinance on November 13, 2005. The project grant in bold below was increased from \$40,000 to \$55,000 from the housing replacement funds.
