1. AGENDA

On motion by Commissioners Keogh and Roof the agenda was adopted.

2. PUBLIC FORUM

3. MOTIONS:

3.01. Authorization to request at renewal the past three months individual trip records.

On a motion by Commissioners Keogh and Roof the request for past three months of individual records was adopted.

AB explained that in both ordinances state that past records are to be kept. This is to be requested to help Ordinance Committee come up with a fee schedule with supporting data.

JM asked if this includes Uber.

AB replied yes.

GM explained on July 18, Ordinance committee is meeting to work out a fee schedule and having this documentation can be shown to determine the fees. Some companies may have issues with giving this information to the Administration. This data is not to be shared but to get rough data for the fee schedule.

GM stated the ordinance states it is required to keep this but not to give it to us. First step is to request and will go from there to see if it is provided. If we don't get the information from the companies we will go from there.

JF inquired if we could request Uber logs.

GM stated that Uber only is requested to provide driver, car and background information.

AB stated in ordinance it does state companies can be audited. If they don't keep records now they will be keeping them by the time all audits will be required in November. If companies don't want us to charge high for pick up or drop offs in Burlington they may want to provide this information so we can have more accurate data.

3.02. Authorization to extend 10 Year or Newer Vehicle for Hire Vehicle until November 2016.

On a motion by Commissioners Keogh and Roof to approve the extension of 10 years or older vehicles can be approved until November 1, 2016.

AB stated this was brought up in few meetings back that with renewals going out so late this will give companies a couple months to get newer cars.

GM stated the ordinance has been effect since mid-April. Companies should have read this and know the rules.

JM replied that the past ordinance stated all drivers need to read the ordinance, don't believe it is in the new one.

GM said reading the ordinance should be done by any driver in this industry to know their rights.

AB replied even though companies should have read the ordinance she just don't want to give them two weeks' notice they need newer cars.

GM believed transitional time to get cars is reasonable.

AR stated this is reasonable that all businesses need to update their equipment.
