Register to vote

With this form, you can register to vote in local elections in Burlington. You can also use this form to:

- Report a change of address
- Report a name change

How to return this form

Return your completed and signed form to the Burlington City Clerk. You can:

- Drop it off in person or mail it to 149 Church Street, Burlington, VT, 05401
- Email it to <u>burlingtontownclerk@burlingtonvt.gov</u>

Are you eligible to register?

To be eligible to vote in Burlington's local elections, you must:

- Be a resident of Burlington and reside in the United States on a permanent or indefinite basis in compliance with federal immigration laws
- Take, or have previously taken the Voter's Oath
- Be 18 or older on Election Day

If the City Clerk or Board of Civil Authority finds that you are not eligible to vote, you will receive a notice that states why your application was rejected.

Your Identity

You must provide your date of birth and your place of birth. You must also provide 1 of the following:

- Your VT Driver's License or Personal I.D. (PID) number
- If you do not have a VT DL or PID #, you may present an alternate verification document. Acceptable forms of alternate ID are one of the following:
 - Current and valid photo ID
 - o Bank statement, utility bill, or government document with your name and current address

Registering for the 1st time?

If you are registering to vote in Burlington for the 1st time, you must complete the Voter's Oath. If you do not take oaths, you may take it as an affirmation.

If you are a 1st time registrant **and** you are mailing this form to your city clerk, you must also submit a photocopy of an acceptable form of ID. Acceptable forms of ID are one of the following:

- Current and valid photo ID
- o Bank statement, utility bill, or government document with your name and current address

Your Rights

If you were provided with this application form by a voter registration agency, you may decline to register. If you decline to register, your failure to register will remain confidential and will be used only for voter registration purposes. If you are submitting this application through a voter registration agency, the office through which you submitted this application will remain confidential and will be used only for voter registration purposes
