Subject: Pine Street and Lakeside Avenue Intersection Improvements

The Department of Public Works (DPW) is about to begin repairs to the Pine Street and Lakeside Avenue Intersection. This notice is to alert residents and businesses that will be impacted by the project, provide information about the activities, and identify the contact at DPW should you have any questions and concerns.

What is planned:

The Pine Street and Lakeside Avenue Intersection project will include installation of new pedestrian signals, new mast arm traffic signals, a new commercial driveway entrance, new concrete sidewalks and ADA compliant sidewalk ramps. To complete the planned work **it is necessary to periodically reduce travel lanes on Pine Street**. Pedestrian traffic will also be rerouted while a portion of the eastern sidewalk is being reconstructed. Construction traffic control signs will be in place to direct vehicles and pedestrians.

When:

Work is scheduled to start the week of **October 5, 2015** and continue for approximately 5 weeks. There will likely be a brake in construction activity for part of November and December while the new traffic signal equipment is being manufactured. Installation of the new traffic signal equipment is scheduled for late December of 2015 and early January of 2016.
