UPDATE:
Nighttime Work on North Avenue

The Department of Public Works (DPW) will be conducting nighttime and daytime construction work on North Avenue between Dodds Court and Washington Street.

The current dates of work are June 22-25, 2016 to remove markings and beginning June 27 to apply new pavement markings, though these dates are weather dependent.

Start Dates & Updates

The start date is weather dependent. Modifications to the start date will be posted on electronic message boards near Plattsburg Avenue, the VT 127 entrance to North Avenue, and at Arthur Park, across from the Burlington High School Field. Night 1: June 22

- No earlier than 7p.m. and through the night, concluding no later than 6a.m. on June 23.
- The work that will be done on the first night involves machines to remove paint on the roadway from Washington Street to Dodds Court. The loudest work will consist of the grinding of existing pavement markings; there will be significant construction noise this night. There will be lights present to illuminate the work zone.

After grinding occurs there will be temporary markings in place until new markings are applied. Please use caution while driving on North Ave during this time.

Night 2, 3 & 4 (as needed): June 23 - 25

- No earlier than 7p.m. and through the night, concluding no later than 6a.m. each morning.
- The work that will be done this night involves grinding of the road. There will be lights present to illuminate the work zone and there may be construction noise.

Beginning June 27 (weather dependent)

- Nighttime work no earlier than 7p.m. and through the night, concluding no later than 6a.m. each morning. Daytime work may occur between 9a.m. – 3p.m.
- Work will involve moderate construction noise with paint machines operating and lights in use.
- Additional details on the schedule after June 27 will be posted as they are provided by the contractor.

Parking

Effective June 8th and for the duration of the pilot project, there will be no on-street parking between Washington Street and Plattsburg Avenue, with the following exception: *on-street parking in front of St. Mark's Parish will remain in place*. All other vehicles parked on the roadway between Washington Street and Plattsburg Avenue will be ticketed and towed.
