Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

1 That WHEREAS, the City and the Burlington Police Officers' Association (BPOA) have been negotiating
2 the terms and conditions of a successor agreement to the Collective Bargaining Agreement that expired on
3 June 30, 2013; and

4 WHEREAS, through the process of Interest Based Bargaining, the negotiating teams of the parties
5 have reached a Tentative Agreement for a new one-year agreement, effective retroactively to July 1, 2013
6 (unless otherwise specified), which is attached to this Resolution; and

7 WHEREAS, the BPOA has ratified this Tentative Agreement at a meeting on April 11, 2014;

8 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby ratifies the Tentative
9 Agreement and authorizes Mayor Miro Weinberger to execute a Collective Bargaining Agreement between
10 the City and the BPOA for a one year period from July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014, in substantially the form
11 attached hereto, subject to the final review and approval of the City Attorney and Chief Administrative
12 Officer.
