

Burlington Urban Agricultural Opportunities

All of the urban agricultural opportunities (UAO) presented here are greater than one acre in size. Based on the methodology used to generate the UAO, some locations, such as baseball fields, have the potential to be used for agriculture but are realistically unlikely to be used for this purpose. However, they remain here because of their potential, similar in nature to the possible conversion of impervious surfaces, such as, parking lots. The UAO presented here were generated by geoprocessing the following data layers: classified 2004 CCMPO orthoimagery (classified by Jarlath Oneil-Dunne at the UVM Spatial Analysis Lab), 2007 Prime Soils (VCGI), Wetlands (City of Burlington) and slope derived from the VT Hydro DEM Data (VCGI).
