### NARRATIVE:

On January 11, 2015 at approximately 02:36 am, the Burlington Police received a report of a male leaving the parking lot of Dunkin Donuts immediately following the sound of glass breaking. Minutes later, a second call was received indicating that a person matching the description of the male was across the street in the parking lot of Koffee Kup Bakery possibly damaging vehicles. The male was last seen running east on Riverside Avenue towards the City of Winooski.

Upon checking the Dunkin Donuts parking lot, it was discovered that a large store front window had been smashed. Follow up investigation revealed that the male suspect had also been inside the Cumberland Farms prior to this incident.

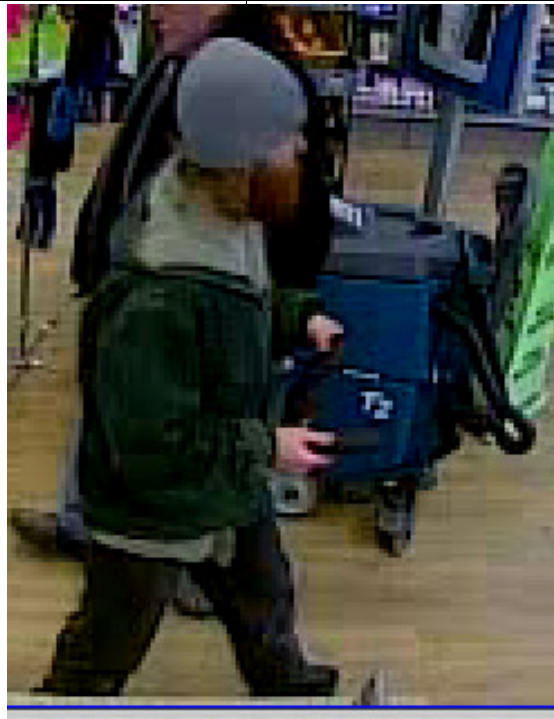
