NARRATIVE:

On November 18, 2015, William Nelson (age 47 of Burlington/Fairfax) was arraigned on the charge of Violation of Conditions of Release and detained for lack of bail. Members of the Burlington Police Department initiated an investigation into Nelson after receiving information from citizens about him being in Burlington in violation of his court ordered curfew.

Nelson was identified as the person responsible for a rash of residential burglaries centered in the area of King Street, Pine Street, Maple Street and the surrounding areas of Burlington spanning from May through September of 2015. Nelson had been charged with Burglary and Possession of Stolen Property on October 19, 2015 and had been released on conditions, including that he abide by a twenty-four hour curfew at a residence outside of Burlington.

Nelson is currently being held at the Northwest Correctional Center for lack of bail.
