NARRATIVE:

On Saturday, December 10, 2016 at approximately 11:00AM, the Burlington Police Department was notified of a robbery that had just occurred at the Kinney Drug Store located on Shelburne Road in Burlington. The suspect was described very similarly to the suspect in the Lakeside Pharmacy robbery the previous evening.

The suspect did not display a weapon but made threats that he had a weapon and would use it if the employees did not comply with his orders. The male left with an undisclosed amount of cash and prescription pills that were stolen during the robbery.

Responding officers quickly located Brett Boucher hiding nearby in a wooded area off of Shelburne Road. Boucher was located with items and medication believed to have been stolen during the robbery that had just occurred as well as matching the description of the suspect.

Boucher matched the description of the person responsible for both robberies (Lakeside and Kinney) and was taken into custody. Boucher was lodged at the Chittenden County

§ 608. Assault and robbery

(a) A person who assaults another and robs, steals, or takes from his or her person or in his or her presence money or other property which may be the subject of larceny shall be imprisoned for not more than 10 years.

(b) A person who, being armed with a dangerous weapon, assaults another and robs, steals or takes from his or her person or in his or her presence money or other property which may be the subject of larceny shall be imprisoned for not more than 15 years nor less than one year.
