### NARRATIVE:

At approximately 2021 hours this morning officers responded to a reported disturbance on Hyde Street. The victim reported that a male suspect entered her residence without her consent and pointed a firearm at her stating that if she called the police he would kill her. The male then left the area on foot and no one was injured.

The victim and suspect were known to each other and with the help of the victim; the suspect was identified as Dominique Perry of Burlington. The victim indicated the reason Perry had come to her house threatening to kill her if she called the police was due to an earlier drug related dispute between Perry and the victim.

Officers responded to Perry's address on Pomeroy Street near Hyde Street. While there Perry attempted to evade police by crawling out a basement window. An Officer who was posted outside that window was able to take Perry into custody.

Also recovered at the time of Perry's arrest was a 9 mm handgun and approximately 19.9

grams of crack cocaine.

Perry was charged with Assault and Robbery, Conspiracy, Two counts of sale of heroin, and possession of cocaine. Perry was taken to court for arraignment on these charges however according to court officials Perry has not yet been brought before a Judge.

Also arrested was Sara Whritenour of Burlington. It does not appear that Whritenour was involved in the disturbance however she did have several outstanding warrants for her arrest. These included Larceny from a person, Identity theft, and False Information to a police officer. Whritenour was transported to court for arraignment on these warrants.

Later this morning police obtained a warrant to search Perry's residence. During the search police located a second handgun and ten bags of suspected heroin.

All the individuals involved in this incident were known to each other. This was not a random act of violence and other than the victim no other members of the public were at a direct risk of harm.
