**NARRATIVE:**

The Burlington Police Department is currently investigating two incidents of vandalism which occurred over the weekend at two different locations. One residence is on Blodgett St. and the other residence on North Prospect St. had windows broken by projectiles, likely from an air gun. Both residences had lawn signs posted showing support for Burlington teachers. The residence on Blodgett St. also displayed a Black Lives Matter lawn sign in addition to a LGBTQ pride flag. The initial investigation indicates that the residences vandalized were the only locations targeted on their respective blocks. The police department is approaching these investigations as if they are related and bias-motivated in nature.
