

DRIVEWAY ENCROACHMENT IS NOW ILLEGAL IN BURLINGTON !



What is Driveway Encroachment? Driveway Encroachment is when a vehicle is parked too close to a driveway making it difficult to get in and out of the driveway. The City considers a vehicle is parked too close to a driveway when any part of the vehicle is **within 2 feet of a driveway as measured from the straight-line edge of a driveway.**

When and where is this in effect? Driveway Encroachment will be a ticketable offense beginning on **October 19, 2016** and will apply to **all driveways within the Burlington city limits 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.**

How much is the ticket? Tickets will be issued at \$75 for each offense.

Anything else I need to know? As always, it's a ticketable **AND towable** offense to actually **block a driveway.** You're blocking a driveway if your car crosses over the straight-line edge of a driveway.
