## Relocation Unit Information

The Burlington Lead Program Relocation Unit is a 3-bed/1-bath furnished unit in the South End of Burlington (near T.J. Maxx) which tenants can stay in for the duration of the lead hazard reduction work. The unit is completely furnished; internet, basic cable, and a telephone are provided for. To stay in the unit, tenants must first sign an agreement which describes the unit residential rules and further information.

Below is a suggested packing list for the relocation unit. Lead reduction work is expected to take 10 days or less, but tenants should pack in preparation to be out of their home for up to 2 weeks, in case there are unexpected delays. Tenants who are temporarily relocating into the unit should consider taking the following with them while staying there:

- Clothing: bring weather appropriate clothing; clothes hangers are provided and a washer and dryer are available a block away from the unit.
  - Shirts, pants/shorts, underclothes, diapers, socks, shoes/boots, gloves/hats/scarves, sweaters, jackets/coats, eyeglasses/sunglasses, watches/belts/jewelry, etc.
- Toiletries: we provide toilet paper, hand soap, and paper towels. We do not provide any cloths or towels. Please consider bringing the following to be prepared:
  - Medications, shampoo/conditioner/body wash/soap, toothbrushes/toothpaste/floss, hairbrush/comb/hair products, blow dryer, lotion/moisturizer/skin products, makeup, razor/shaving cream, baby wipes, bath towels/wash cloths/hand towels, etc.
- Bedding: the unit contains 1 queen, 1 twin, and 2 full beds. The beds are protected by mattress covers, but we do not provide anything that we would need to launder after use. Please make sure to bring your own bedding:
  - Sheets, comforters, blankets, duvets, linens, pillows, pillow cases, crib/bassinet, etc.
- Valuables: Please make sure to bring your valuables with you or ensure that they are packed away safely and securely:
  - Wallet/credit cards/cash/checks/purse, identification, keys, jewelry, etc.
- Kitchen Supplies: The unit has a fully equipped kitchen and a \$50 Price Chopper gift card is given to those who choose to stay in the unit
- Pets: If you have a pet or pets that you would like to stay with you in the unit, please let us know. If we cannot allow for the pet(s) to stay at the relocation unit, we can pay for boarding services.
