UPDATE OF THE SIDEWALK AND PEDESTRIAN INFRASTRUCTURE
INVENTORY AND ASSESSMENT

The City of Burlington is requesting proposals from qualified firms (Consultants) for the "Update of the Sidewalk and Pedestrian Infrastructure, Inventory and Assessment". The purpose of this project is to improve the methodology the City uses to prioritize sidewalk repair projects. To achieve this, the selected consultant must perform an inventory of the entire City Pedestrian Infrastructure (approx. 150 mi. of sidewalk and 988 curb ramps). The selected consultant must also create a geo-referenced database with the information collected and propose improvements to the existing methodology or develop a new methodology for prioritization of improvements. A detailed scope of work is outlined in the Request for Proposals (RFP).

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION: Proposals must be received electronically no later than 11:00 AM (Eastern Time) on May 6th, 2014. Proposals received after this deadline will not be accepted.
