SAFETY

Drivers: the speed in Burlington is 25 MPH unless otherwise posted. Only pass cyclists when safe and give **AT LEAST** three feet of room when passing.



Cyclists:
Ride **WITH** Traffic,
NOT AGAINST.

Invest in a secure lock that is not easily broken or cut. Avoid using only cable locks.



Practice good locking methods. Do not use trees - Your bike could be impounded!

Be sure your bike is in good working order and the brakes adjusted properly

Burlington requires bicycles to have lights (white on front, red on back) from 1/2 hour after sunset **TO** 1/2 hour before sunrise in addition to a reflector.



Bicyclists must obey the same rules of the road that cars do (like stopping at stop signs and red lights).



Record your bike's serial number. Without this, a recovered bike is less likely to be returned



Always wear helmets and protective gear when riding.
