On 03/04/2015 at approximately 1939 hours, the Burlington Police responded to Hannaford grocery store on North Avenue for a pharmaceutical robbery.

The suspect approached the pharmacist and demanding narcotics. The suspect implied that he had a weapon, however, no weapon was displayed. The suspect subsequently fled the store on foot, with a partial bottle of narcotics in hand. No one was injured during the incident.

A K-9 unit was summoned and conducted a track, but eventually lost the scent at a roadway.

The suspect is described as a white male, mid-30s, 5'10 - 6'2, large build, wearing a dark green zip-up sweatshirt, a blue medical mask, blue medical gloves, tan cargo pants and white sneakers.
