NARRATIVE:

As previously released, on April 1, 2014 at approximately 1330 hours, the Burlington Police Department responded to Dot's Market in the Old North End of Burlington for a report of an attempted robbery. The clerk there reported that a white male, approximately 6 feet tall, thin to medium build, no facial hair, wearing a red hooded sweatshirt under a green zip-up fleece, blue denim jeans, and black sandals had come into the store and attempted to take money from the cash drawer.

Investigation had yielded still images from store surveillance of the suspect in this case and the images are attached here for reference and distribution. The Burlington Police Department asks that any persons who recognize this individual are asked to contact Detective Nash or CrimeStoppers. A cash reward is being offered for information that leads an arrest in this case.
