

Follow up on the 14BU16597 press release: On June 26<sup>th</sup> Michael Norton was arraigned in Vermont Superior Court on the above-mentioned charges and released on conditions. At 1358 hours, Burlington Police Officers located Norton back on the Church Street Marketplace where he was subsequently arrested for violating his **Conditions of Release**. During today's encounter and since having been released back on conditions, Norton was also charged with **Unlawful Trespass** for entering Rite Aid when an active trespass notice existed, and **Disorderly Conduct** (2 counts) for causing a disturbance inside City Market whereas he threw a bottle of orange juice at the feet of an employee, and causing a public inconvenience on Cherry St and Church St when police attempted to make contact with him.

Norton was lodged at the Chittenden County Correctional Center.
