The City of Burlington is proposing to pave your street in 2023, starting as early as July.

Now is the time to consider replacing water & sewer services –

Potential for cost savings for homeowners.

Water: DPW will plan to replace galvanized water services in the roadway before paving (main to curb stop) at no cost to property owners as timing and resources allow. Due to higher than normal planned construction in 2023 we may utilize contractors to assist with water service work. The cost of service work outside the roadway (curb stop to building) is 100% the responsibility of the property owner per city ordinance. Galvanized pipe is no longer used for water services because it is likely to break and reduce flow capacity over time. We offer estimates and recommend property owners with galvanized pipe consider replacing the remainder of their service at this time. Please note, we offer flexible payment plans (e.g., interest free, 24 month terms) for waterline work. **You will receive a separate letter from DPW-Water, if our records indicate you have a galvanized or unknown service type.**

An example of corrosion in a galvanized waterline is below:



Sewer: The repair & replacement costs for sewer laterals are 100% the responsibility of the property owner per city ordinance. If your sewer lateral has never been assessed then we recommend hiring a contractor to video the pipe condition. This will provide valuable information about the condition of your sewer pipe and gives you the chance to plan for repairs before an emergency strikes. We suggest this work take place now in order to minimize future disruptions to the roadway once paving is completed. DPW-Water is currently offering a rebate of up to \$250 for sewer lateral video inspections with limited funding available on a first come, first served basis. Review program details and requirements by visiting burlingtonvt.gov/water/WRAP.

Deadlines: By **May 14, 2023**, we must have written notification of your intent to do water or sewer service upgrade work. Sewer service work must be completed by **July 29, 2023**.
