

QUALIFYING ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What do you mean by qualifying assistance program?

We will accept programs that require participants to be at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines or 50% of HUD's Area Median Income.
