









Project: A DPW Water Resources contractor will begin work to replace an old sewer line as early as April 15th. This project has been planned under the Clean Water Resiliency Plan and is funded through the State SRF program - helping to limit the impact to ratepayers.

Why: This is an old sewer line with a high risk and consequence of failure. This work will protect against unplanned, emergency repairs, fortify our downtown infrastructure and add additional capacity to our system.

Impacts: The project will last up to 1 month. Work takes place M-F 7AM-6PM. There will be occasional gaps in between phases of work. The traffic control plan may include a closure of the Pine/College intersection for ~3 days at the start of the project. Following that, Pine between College & Bank will be oneway for the duration of the work. Parking on this stretch will be removed during construction.
