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## GISC SPLIT PILL INCENTIVE PROGRAM

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### **CUT THE PILL, CUT THE BILL**

The idea is a simple one. Your doctor writes you a mail order prescription for half the number of pills of a qualifying drug, at twice your normal dose. You split the pills in half, and your mail order co-pay is waived. You pay nothing (\$0.00).

### **HOW THE SPLIT PILL INCENTIVE WORKS**

This program only applies to mail order prescriptions for qualifying drugs.

If you are prescribed Crestor **10mg** and told to take **1 tablet** per day, you would normally receive 90 tablets through Mail Order at your normal Mail Order co-pay.

However, if your doctor writes the mail order prescription for 45 tablets of Crestor **20mg** with directions to take  $\frac{1}{2}$  **tablet** daily...the result is:

1. You are still getting the prescribed dose of Crestor 10mg per day.
2. You are still getting a ninety day supply of Crestor.
3. The Plan waives your Mail Order co-pay, you pay nothing (\$0.00).

The reverse side of this sheet is a listing of drugs that qualify for the GISC Split Pill Incentive Program at \$0 co-pay through Maxor Mail Order. Take this Split Pill drug listing with you to your doctor's office so you can discuss the program. It is important to talk to your doctor before splitting your pills to make sure it is safe and appropriate for you.

The physician should write a maintenance mail order prescription for 45 days and double the dosage, for maintenance drugs to be split in half.

Example: A mail order drug prescription written for 90 days at 10mg now needs to be written for 45 days at 20mg. This allows for the pill to be cut in half for the correct dosage. The physician can fax the script to Maxor Mail Order at 866-589-7656.
