Options for Tier 1 and Tier 2

1st option - Place the CE project along with \$84,250 for Branches in Tier 2. This is a strategic placement as both projects would score better in Tier 2 (due to their project type - 10 points each). **The Alliance chose this option for Tier 2.**

2nd option - Place the Safe Haven project in Tier 2 as the lowest scoring project. It will only score 3 points due to its project type.

There are additional points awarded in Tier 2 for the type of application. PSH, HMIS, TH for Youth and SSO - Coordinated Assessment will all score 10 points each. Everything else scores either 3 points or 1 point so there are some strategies there.
