In order to comply with the Vermont Electrical Safety Rules, the City of Burlington will be requiring permits and inspections for all wiring, regardless of voltage, in or on any public buildings (as defined in VSA 26, Chapter 15). The only exceptions to this would be telecommunications wiring and security system wiring.

- Permits for this type of work must be drawn for all control work and other low voltage wiring currently in progress.
- All control wiring will require rough and final inspections. Any person performing electrical work, regardless of the voltage, is required to be licensed as an electrician (as described in VSA 26, Chapter 15).
- The permit and inspection processes will be the same as for all other electrical work and per City Ordinances.
- If the control wiring is being done in conjunction with other building wiring, at the discretion of the electrical inspector, the control wiring may be inspected at the same time as the building wiring, eliminating the need for the control wiring contractor to be present.
