Termination of Agreement:

Failure to renew will result in termination of this agreement. In the event you wish to terminate this agreement before the end of your rental period, contact DPW and arrange a time to return the key. Upon receipt of the key, the key deposit will be returned to you by mailed check. The rental fee is non-refundable.

Permitted Use:

Your assigned locker shall be used only for the purpose of securing a bicycle and bicycle-related equipment. Under NO circumstances may the bicycle locker be used for any other purpose. Any items stored within the locker that are not bicycle related may be removed by the City your expense and may be subject to disposal without your consent. Items removed from your locker may be subject to a reasonable storage fee that must be paid prior to the release of any item.

Inspection:

The City of Burlington reserves the right to open and inspect bike lockers at any time, for any reason and without notice in order to ensure they are being used in a manner consistent with their intended use. Lockers may also be opened at any time without notice in order to perform necessary maintenance.


Liability Limits:

While bicycle lockers provide an additional level of security over regular bicycle racks, they are not guaranteed against theft or damage. The City of Burlington is not responsible for any damages to any items left in the locker resulting from any cause. You are responsible for ensuring the locker is properly secured.
